THE AJARAKH'S

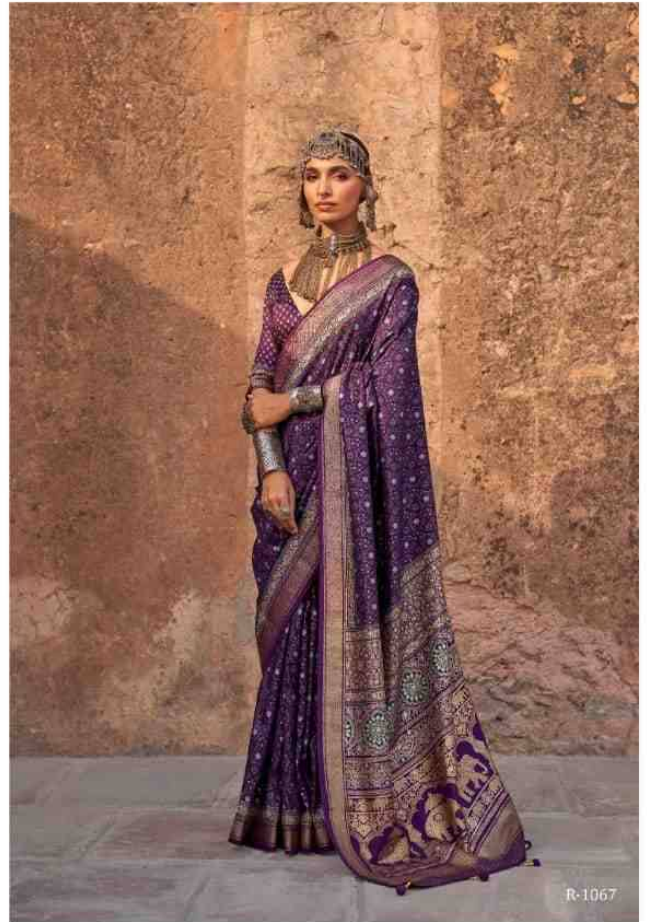
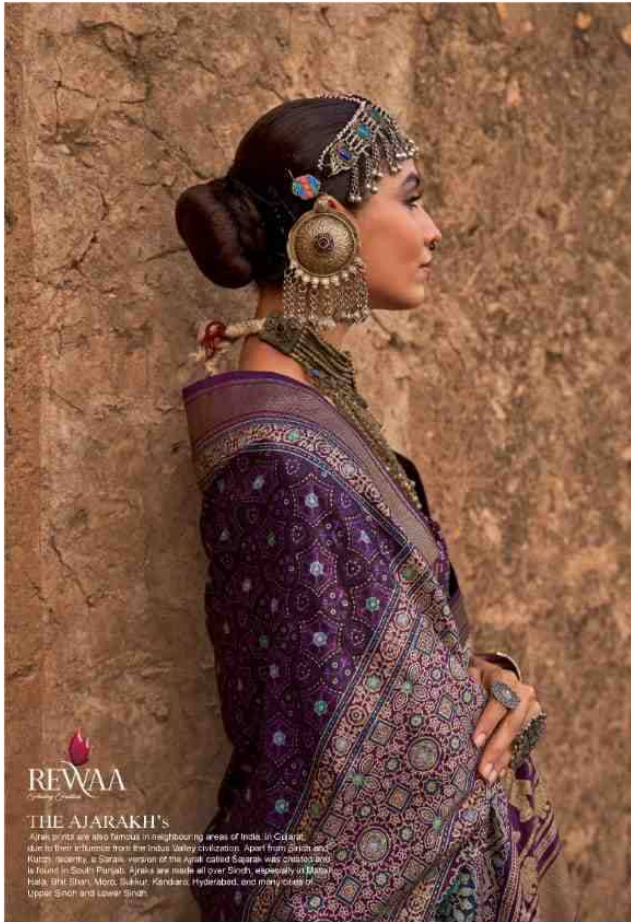
